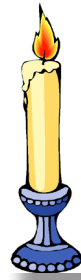

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

How will you respond to the command of Jesus to go out and preach the Gospel?

The Ascension of Jesus is a call to the baptized. It marks the end of Jesus' historical mission and the beginning of our own commission to proclaim the gospel. We are not forced to proclaim the gospel, nor do we do this by our own authority.



Always, the mission is Christ's. We accomplish it by the strength and life of the Spirit, who dwells in the baptized. It is the Holy Spirit who works in us. This is why ordinary people can, with enthusiasm, commitment and love, take up Jesus' mission to bring the Good News to the world.

As baptized Christians, we carry out Christ's mission in a variety of ways. We hear the Word so our hearts and spirits will be renewed; we speak the Word so others might know Christ and come to believe in him; we live the Word so that our actions will change the world through justice and service.

The public can deposit prescription drugs in a secured container anytime Monday - Friday, from 8 AM - 5 PM. The office is closed from noon - 1 PM.
